Hawaii Blues keep close watch on network

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Hawaii, the largest provider of healthcare in the state, has completed its initial deployment of WatchTower, software developed by San Francisco-based CITTIO. The insurer will use the network management technology to monitor corporate computing equipment running custom and third-party applications. Known locally as Hawaii Medical Service Association, the organization operates a complex 500-node network composed of Windows and UNIX servers, networking, and storage equipment from a number of vendors.
